At San Francisco Health Service System (SFHSS), we strive to provide the most convenient, secure and easiest methods of enrolling in your annual benefits every year. We are excited to introduce *eBenefits*, our new online Open Enrollment system that allows you to enroll in your annual benefits online.

As you know, Open Enrollment for the 2019 plan year will take place between October 1 to 31, 2018. You can save time and a trip to SFHSS by registering today to create a new account at the City and County of San Francisco's employee portal, where our **eBenefits Online Open Enrollment** site is located.

#### Here's what you need to do.

Within a few days, you will be receiving a temporary code in the mail that you will use to set up your *eBenefits* account. It is critical you set up your account as soon as you receive your temporary code in the mail, *before* the Open Enrollment period begins as your temporary code will expire.

Once you set up your account, you can look forward to making your health benefit elections online this year and the years to follow! It's that simple.

Be sure to hold on to this letter, which includes important information including your Employee ID Number (for most retirees, this will be your former employee "DSW" number). You will need to provide your Employee ID Number, along with your temporary code (which you will receive in a separate letter), when you log into the employee portal for the first time.

As soon as you receive your temporary code in the mail, go to https://bifrost.sfgov.org and enter your Employee ID (DSW) Number, exactly as it appears in the top right of this letter, for your username and the temporary code for your password. Please note that this is a *secure site* that is managed by the City and County of San Francisco's Department of Technology.

You will need to agree to the Privacy Policy by clicking the agree button before you get started. You will find more detailed instructions at sfhss.org/eBenefits/GettingStarted.html. Once you have logged in with your temporary code, you will create a new password that you can use in the future.

Enter your elections and submit your choices by 5:00pm PST on October 31st, 2018. If you are adding new dependents, you will need to submit supporting documentation, which can be uploaded online.




