Objectives of Trio

- To provide a cost effective, alternative HMO option for actives and early retirees that is more affordable than the current BSC Access+ program
- Create competition in the marketplace
- Transform health care delivery
- To ensure everyone has access to high-quality care at an affordable price

What is Trio?

- A high efficiency network of premier hospitals and providers
- Trio includes more than 12,000 high quality physicians focused on coordinated care, improving the patient experience and lowering the cost of care
- Trio is a plan offering HSS members the same plan design, lower contributions, with access to many of the same doctors they use today
- The Trio network is developed by leveraging Blue Shield's deep provider and HMO ACO partnerships
- SFHSS current ACO partners, John Muir, Hill Physicians and Brown
 & Toland are in Trio

Trio Network

- Trio includes current Medical Groups covering 70% of HSS members today:
 - Brown & Toland
 - Hill Physicians
 - John Muir
 - Meritage
 - Santa Clara Independent Physician Association
- Trio includes most of the hospitals related to these medical groups
- Trio does not include Sutter providers (inpatient/outpatient providers)
- Trio does not include California Pacific Medical Center(s) (Sutter) in San Francisco, even if referred by Brown & Toland



Trio Communications Approach: Ensure a smooth transition

- ■Robust rollout and education targeted to employees and early retirees
- ■Introduce Trio and address employee questions and concerns:
 - Be clear about Brown & Toland (B&T) Trio members no longer having access to California Pacific Medical Center (CPMC)
 - Highlight the services/quality of Dignity and UCSF hospitals
 - Share key benefits of Trio: affordability, same benefits as Access+ HMO and personalized support through Shield Concierge
- ■Provide targeted communications to key audiences:
 - Members currently with Trio PCPs
 - Families that currently have a mix of Trio and non-Trio PCPs
 - Members without Trio PCPs
- Partner with ACO partners (B&T, Hill Physicians, and other Trio providers) to support OE events/webinars and communicate with members.
- ■Provide HSS Benefits Staff with talking points and training about the Trio HMO plan.

Members w/ Trio PCPs (who will be auto-enrolled)	 Letter/email blast: Letter explains the benefits & features of the Trio ACO HMO plan and each medical groups services. Inform them of hospital affiliation change. Partner with B&T and Hill Physicians to co-branded letter. Out-bound calls: Calls to members who will be enrolled (Blue Shield or the Trio medical groups)
Members (Families) w/mixed PCPs (Trio/non-Trio)	Letter/email blast:Introduce Trio with key messagingInform them of hospital affiliation change.
HMO members who do not currently have Trio PCPs	Letter/email blast:Introduce Trio with key messaging.

Trio Renewal Offer

- Trio to be offered alongside the current HMO Access+ plan members enrolled in Access+ in 2017 who do not actively choose a Blue Shield option will be automatically enrolled in the lowest cost option
- Trio is being offered with a three year rate guarantee
 - 2018 Trio Renewal is 10% lower than 2018 Access+
 - Trio 2019 Rate Cap is 5.9%
 - Trio 2020 Rate Cap is 8.5%
- Provider Partners are investing in offering Trio to HSS members
- Blue Shield and Provider Partners are investing in clinical innovations
- Blue Shield is investing in a broader Bay Area strategy to ensure high quality, cost-effective health plans for the long term




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
