Stay Healthy this Flu Season

SFHSS is offering FREE FLU SHOT clinics across the city to protect you and your co-workers from this year's flu virus. No appointments required.

Who is eligible for a flu shot at a worksite clinic?

- Employees from CCSF, USD, CCD, and CRT. Worksite clinics are not open to spouses/domestic partners and children of city employees.
- Retirees and their spouses/partners of retirees insured through the SFHSS sponsored health plans from the following employers: CCSF, USD, CCD, and CRT.

Be Prepared

This year, you will need to self-report that you received a flu shot to your healthcare provider.

- Bring a city issued ID badge OR your medical provider card.
- Prior to arrival, <u>please complete and print the Flu</u>
 <u>Consent and Waiver</u> (forms will also be available onsite).
- Take a picture of the consent form after you receive your flu shot.
- Upload the photo to your online health plan account or email the photo to your health care provider.
