BLACKOUT PERIOD NOTICE NOVEMBER 9, 2023, THROUGH JUNE 2024 (see attachment)

Blackout Period notification to the Health Service Board ("Board") that began on November 9, 2023, and extends through both:

- the completion of the San Francisco Health Service System ("SFHSS") formal request for proposal for a Medicare Advantage PPO plan for the 2025 plan year ("2025 MA PPO RFP") and the presentation of the results of the 2025 MA PPO RFP to the Health Service Board, and
- the completion of the SFHSS Annual Rates and Benefits process for the 2025 plan year.

UNITED HEALTHCARE AND UCSF MEDICAL GROUP SITUATION

We are pleased to report that United Healthcare and the UCSF Medical Group have reached agreement for UCSF Medical Group to be an in-network provider for the SFHSS UHC Medicare Advantage Plan, effective January 1, 2024. I appreciate the support of the Health Service Board in your advocacy efforts with both parties to ensure our retirees have access to care from providers practicing within the UCSF Medical Group.

RACIAL EQUITY, DIVERSITY & CULTURAL HERITAGE CELEBRATIONS

SFHSS is uplifting cultural heritage through Black History Month resources linked to community well-being and resiliency. We are encouraging the sharing of resources that help us learn and grow in our respect and inclusivity for one another.

In local news, the <u>Black Joy Parade</u> will be presented by Black Infant Health (BIH) in the City of Oakland for its seventh year. The parade celebrates the Black experience and the community's contribution to history and culture with its signature celebration, partnerships, and event. It exists to provide the Black community and allies with a live experience that celebrates their influence on cultures past, present, and future. The event will be on Sunday, February 25.

Beginning on Dr. Martin Luther King, Jr.'s birthday weekend, during Black History Month, and throughout the year, the <u>San Francisco Public Library</u> champions Black leaders and change-makers in our city and beyond. Visit the <u>African American Center</u> on the 3rd floor of the Main Library to see the new Kenneth Green photography exhibition that focuses on images of Black women whose strength, intellect, and beauty he recognized and paid homage to.

As we reflect on the origins of Black History Month, we recognize the <u>Association for the Study of African American Life and History</u> (ASALH) that selected the national 2024 theme: *African Americans and the Arts*. This theme acknowledges that the African American influence has been paramount in visual and performing arts, literature, fashion, folklore, language, film, music, architecture, culinary, and other forms of cultural expression. The <u>White House Proclamation on National Black History Month</u> also uplifts Black history as American history and Black culture, stories, and triumphs are the core of who we are as a nation.

MEDICARE RFP UPDATE

Between January 11 and January 26, 2024, SFHSS issued three (3) addenda to the Medicare Plan (MAPD PPO) Request for Proposal (RFP) for the 2025 plan year (<u>SFHSS RFP</u> webpage). The addenda included one hundred and twenty-three (123) detailed answers from SFHSS and Aon's Medicare subject-matter experts to all questions submitted by prospective respondents to the RFP. The non-financial questionnaire submission deadline is Friday, February 9, 2024, at 12:00 p.m. (PST). Following receipt of the non-financial questionnaires, SFHSS will confirm the Minimum Qualifications to Bid (MQs). Following confirmation of the MQs, the non-financial questionnaires will be submitted to the RFP Evaluation Panel for review, analysis, discussion, and scoring.

HEALTHCARE AFFORDABILITY BOARD AND ADVISORY COMMITTEE

The Health Care Affordability Board is a decision-making body charged with setting statewide and sector-specific spending targets, appointing a Health Care Affordability Advisory Committee, and approving key benchmarks, such as alternative payment model adoption and the share of spending dedicated to primary care and behavioral health, among other responsibilities. Board members may not receive compensation from healthcare entities.



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





RE: Black-Out Period Notice, November 9, 2023 through June 2024

This memorandum shall serve as the Black-Out Period notification to the Health Service Board ("Board") that will begin today, November 9, 2023, and extend through both:

- the completion of the San Francisco Health Service System ("SFHSS") formal request for proposal for a Medicare Advantage PPO plan for the 2025 plan year ("2025 MA PPO RFP") and the presentation of the results of the 2025 MA PPO RFP to the Board, and
- the completion of the SFHSS Annual Rates and Benefits process for the 2025 plan year.

During this time, Board members are prohibited from unauthorized communications and other prohibited activities in connection with the 2025 MA PPO RFP and the SFHSS Annual Rates and Benefits process for the 2025 plan year.

Pursuant to the Board's Service Provider Selection Policy, the Board must be notified of the start of this Black-Out Period prior to the release of any solicitation for the selection of a primary service provider, as well as prior to the beginning of the annual SFHSS Rates and Benefits process. Such notice is given.

During this Black-Out Period, Board members are prohibited from any communications or activities, with current or potential future service providers, or their representatives, agents or officers, on matters relating to SFHSS competitive bid processes for the selection of the primary service provider for medical plans, including, but not limited to the 2025 MA PPO RFP (collectively, "Unauthorized RFP Communications and Other Prohibited Activities"), except for communications related to SFHSS matters occurring during public meetings of the Board, the Board of Supervisors, or committees thereof.

Unauthorized RFP Communications and Other Prohibited Activities include communications and activities prohibited by state and local laws related to conflicts of interest, including Section 15.103 of the City's Charter, Article III (Conduct of Government Officials and Employees), Chapter 2 (Conflict of Interest and Other Prohibited Activities) of City's Campaign and Governmental Conduct Code, Section 1.126 of the San Francisco Campaign and Governmental Conduct Code (Campaign Reform Ordinance), and Section 87100 et seq. and Section 1090 et seq. of the Government Code of the State of California.

Communications and activities include face-to-face conversations, conversations through one or more third parties or intermediaries, telephone conversations, emails, text messages, letters, faxes, or any other social media, written or electronic communications.

Any communications with current or potential future service providers for reasons unrelated to SFHSS during this period must be immediately disclosed in writing to the Executive Director and the Board.

Past Health Service Board Election Results

<u>2020</u>- One seat expired. The election was canceled because one candidate was a retired member and assumed the seat.

<u>2019</u>- Two seats expired. The election was canceled because one candidate was a Board incumbent and another was an active employee. Both nominees filled the seats.

<u>2015</u>- One seat expired. The election was canceled because there was only one nominee, and the incumbent continued as a Board member.

<u>2014</u>- Two Seats Expired. The election was canceled because no candidate submitted verified nomination forms, and incumbents continued as Board members.



December 2023 Highlights:



December 2023 Compared to November 2023: Calls, Cases, and % of Calls that Led to a Case




December Year Over Year Highlights:
